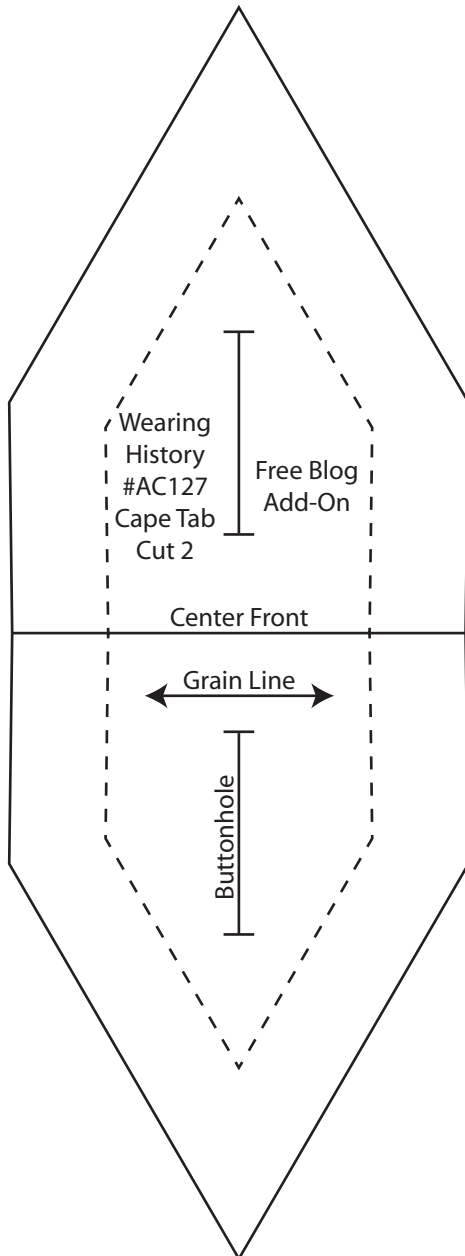

## Free Add-On Wearing History #AC127 "Ponderosa" 1890s Cape

1/2" Seam Allowance Included

Use this tab to fasten the cape at center front.  
Adapt the buttonhole size and spacing as  
needed for your button placement.

Cut 2 of fabric. Stitch right sides together,  
leaving an opening for turning at center front.

Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Clip corners and  
points. Turn right side out and press. Hand  
stitch the opening for turning closed. Top  
stitch 1/8" from finished edge to create a crisp  
edge.

Work buttonholes to the size needed for your  
buttons. Attach the tab to the cape, over the  
hood (if applicable).

Buttons with a shank work best if using with  
the hood view. Keep in mind that shanked  
buttons will be visible from the reverse side  
because of bulk.
